

Adam Bruce Millikan Memorial Scholarship

Scholarship Background:

The Adam Bruce Millikan Endowed Scholarship was established in 2002 in loving memory of Adam by his family and friends. Adam was a Criminal Justice major at the University of Sioux Falls and had completed his freshman year. Adam wanted to be able to positively influence as many lives as possible. At age 19, Adam was closer to achieving his dream than he may have thought. He touched the lives of his family and friends with something far more valuable than money. The steadfast friendship and compassion that he shared are qualities that won't ever be forgotten.

Scholarship Amount: For the 2025-26 academic year, this amount is approximately \$1,500.

Student Eligibility:

High School Senior Students

- First preference to a student wanting to major in Criminal Justice.
- Second preference to a student wanting to major in Psychology.
- First priority shall go to a student who graduates from Lincoln High School.
- ➤ High School students must enter with a 3.25 high school grade point average.
- All applicants must provide a current high school transcript.

Current USF Students

- > First preference to undergraduate student seeking their first bachelor's degree majoring in Criminal Justice.
- Second preference to undergraduate student majoring in Psychology.
- First priority shall go to a student who graduated from Lincoln High School.
- Current USF students must maintain a 3.25 cumulative grade point average (CGPA).
- > All applicants must provide a current USF transcript.

Application Process:

- 1. Complete the attached "Application Form" including all essay responses.
- 2. Select one individual high school students should choose a Social Studies high school teacher; USF students should choose a Social Science professor to write a letter of recommendation.
