

ART SCHOLARSHIPS

Q: Who is eligible for an Art Scholarship?

A: High school seniors who will be enrolled full-time in the coming year as an art major and minor are eligible to submit an Art Portfolio to be considered for an Art Scholarship.

Q: What do I need to include in my art portfolio?

A: In a PowerPoint include 8–12 images of your best work created in high school (grades 10–12).

Q: What types of projects should I incorporate in my art portfolio?

A: You should include your best:

- Design projects
- Illustration and animation
- o Photography, film, video and multimedia projects
- Paintings, drawings and sketches from observation

Q: What should the formatting look like in my PowerPoint portfolio?

A: Use our sample art portfolio as a guide! Be sure to include:

- Picture of work. (Have excellent photographs of your artwork.)
- Title of work.
- Medium used.
- Year created.
- Dimensions.

Q: What are the faculty looking for in an art portfolio?

A: Faculty are looking for:

- Original work created from direct observation.
- A variety of subject matter.
- Finished pieces.

Need help? Don't

- Versatility in a range of different media.
- Your ability to express an opinion, a narrative, a mood, an emotion, perhaps a political statement, etc.

Q: When will I know what I'm being offered?

A: Results are mailed about two weeks following the portfolio submission.
